The digestive system of the goat is different from that of the sheep or the cow. Weed seeds cannot pass through the goat's body, and so they cannot grow into new weeds. Farmers don't like using chemicals to control weeds because such poisons can kill wild animals or even pets, like dogs. A company in Montana even rents out goats to eat weeds.
