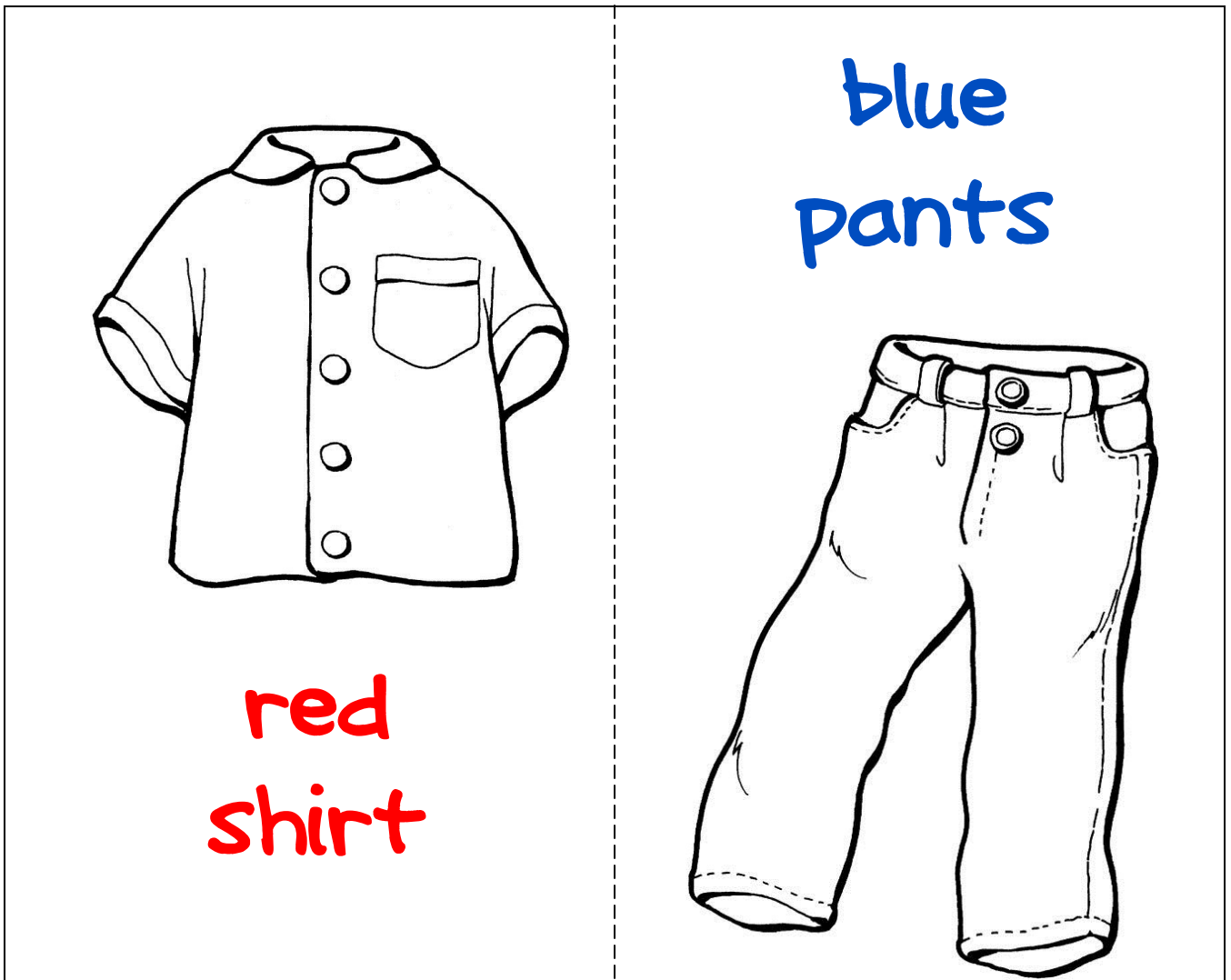
Cut out the foods on this page and let your student paste them on the plate. Don't worry if they aren't perfect or overlap...just let your student have fun with it! :)

If you are making a lapbook, you may want to put the healthy lunch page on the back cover.

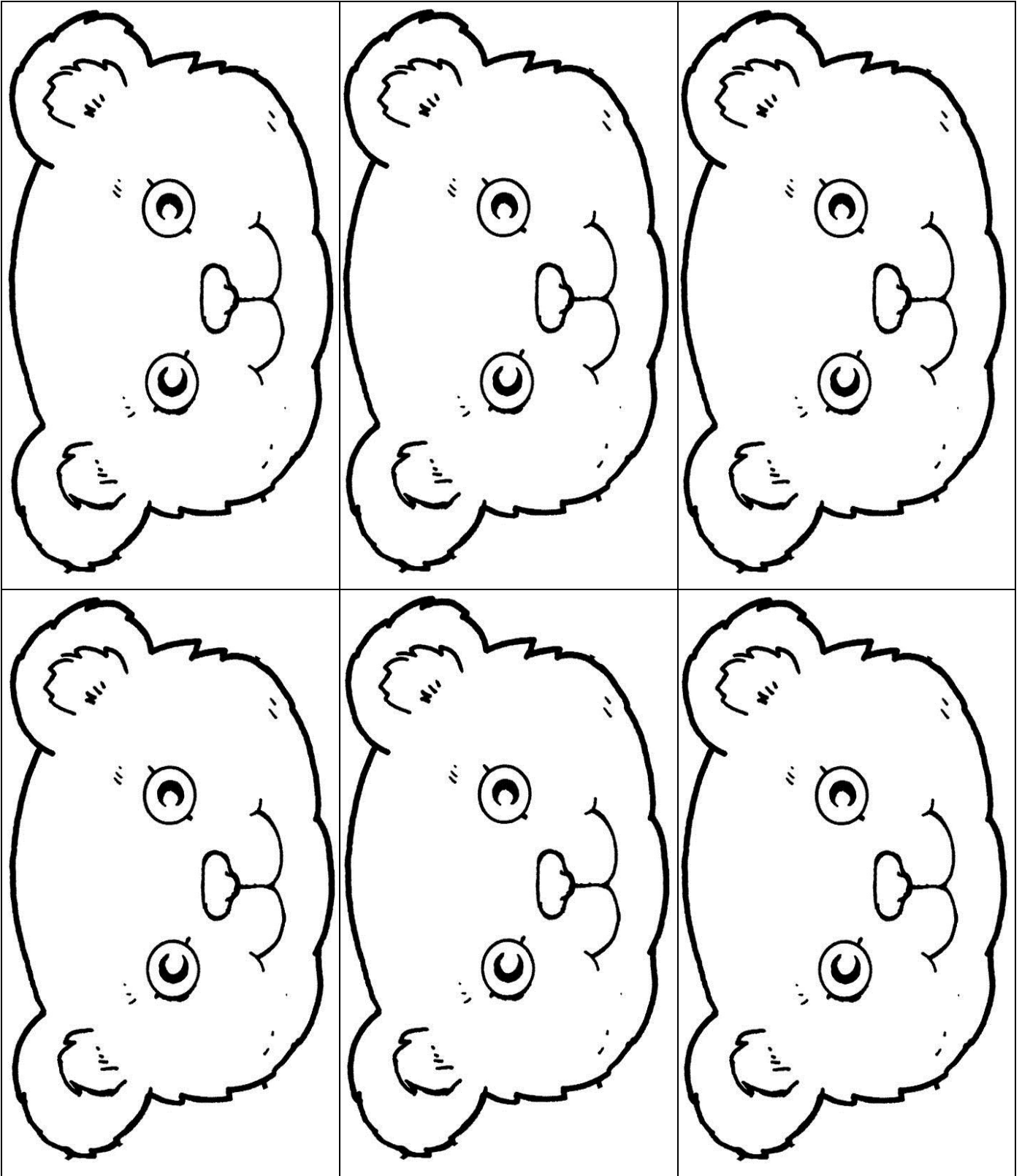

Cut bear cards out. Hide them around the room and let your student try to find them. When he finds them, let him hide the cards and you try to find them. Have fun!



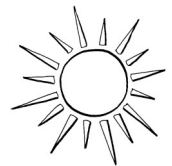

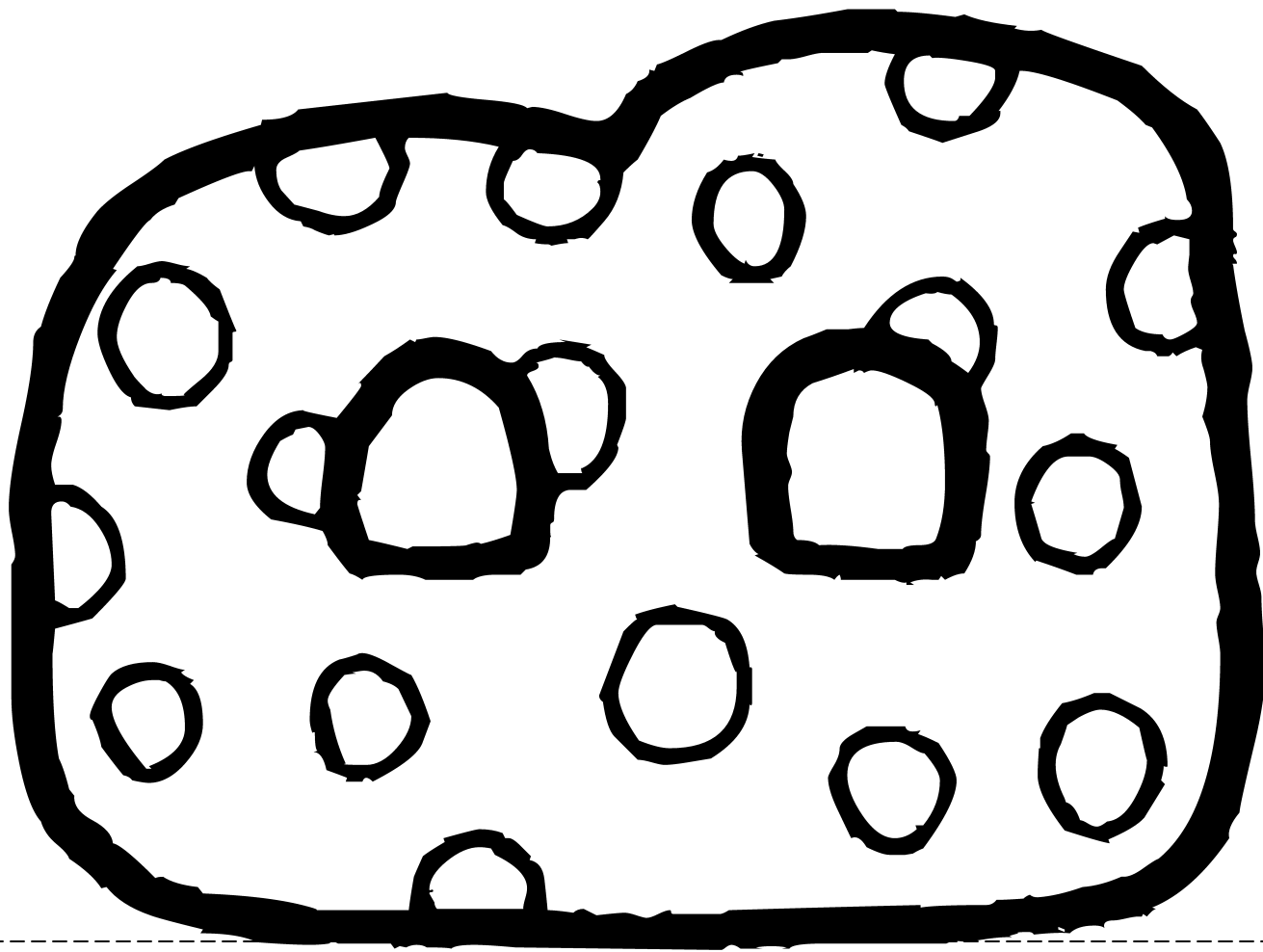


Cut out the tri-fold book on the previous page as one piece. What you see (the text) is the inside of the book. Fold into thirds. Cut out the cover and glue it to the front of the book. Cut out figures on this page. Let your student color them, if desired. Match the figures to the appropriate place on the book. Discuss with your student why we dress certain ways at certain times.

Fold on dotted line. Cut around B shape to form a B shaped book.

Let your student color, cut, and paste the items from the Jesse Bear story that begin with the letter B into the book.

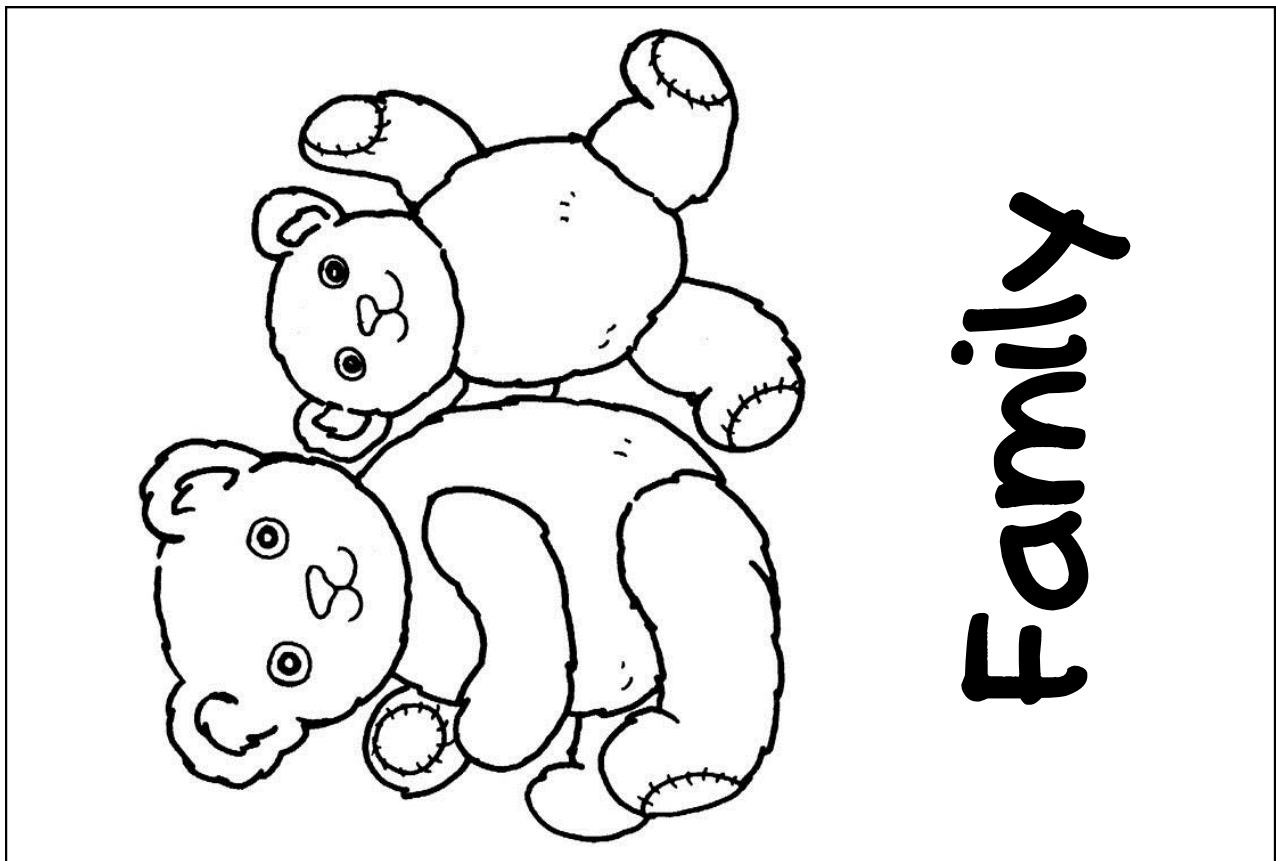




Cut piece on this page out. You will glue this on the front of the book as a cover. Cut book on next page out. Fold in half.
